### March Homework Fun!



Below are some activities related to concepts being taught in our kindergarten classroom. To help your child review and master these concepts, please choose at least 3 activities each week for him/her to do as homework. Circle the activities completed. # Week 1

- 1. Have an adult read a Dr. Seuss story to you.
- 2. Play a board game with an adult. Before a player can move he or she has to read a High Frequency Word.
- 3. Practice coin names and values with the Voki on our classroom website at <a href="http://ribblett.weebly.com">http://ribblett.weebly.com</a>
- 4. What day is today? What day is tomorrow? What day was yesterday? Name all the days of the week in order.

### Week 2

- 1. Write all the numbers from 1 to 20. You might write them with Sidewalk Chalk, paint, a special marker, etc.
- 2. Draw a picture of, and write a story about, what you would like to find at the end of a rainbow.
- 3. Count to 100 by 5's, 10's and 1's. Then, count backwards from 20 by 1's.
- 4. Tell at least two words that rhyme with cat, say, king, top, and can.

## Week 3

- 1. Add up the number of toes in your family. (You might be able to count by 5's and 10's to do this.)
- 2. Practice coin names and values with the Voki on our classroom website at <a href="http://ribblett.weebly.com">http://ribblett.weebly.com</a>.
- 3. Listen to, or read, a story, and retell it to an adult. Be sure to include character names and words from the story.
- 4. Write all your High Frequency Words and read them. You might write them with Sidewalk Chalk, paint, a special marker, etc.

#### Week 4

- 1. Take a nature walk and look for signs of spring.
- 2. Empty a coin jar, or a piggy bank, then sort and count the coins.
- 3. Practice tossing balls at a target (wash basket, wastebasket, bucket, etc.) If playing with a friend, keep score using tally marks.
- 4. Gather some objects from around the house and make 3 addition and 3 subtraction problems for an adult to solve.
