# Verbal Path for the Formation of Letters 

Sometimes it helps children to say aloud the directions for "making" a letter. This "verbal path" helps them to understand the directional movement that is essential. In addition, it gives the teacher and child a language to talk through the letter and its features. Here, we suggest language for creating a verbal path to the distinctive features of letters.

C - pull back, around, up, and down
b - pull down, up, around
C - pull back and around
d - pull back, around, up, and down
e - pull across, back, and around
f - pull back, down, and cross
9 - pull back, around, up, down, and under
h - pull down, up, over, and down

j - pull down, curve around, dot
K — pull down, pull in, pull out
| - pull down
M - pull down, up, over, down and up, over and down
n - pull down, up, over, and down
O - pull back and around
P - pull down, up, and around
